

On April 4, 2019 my friend and I met with Superintendent David Coombs and the trustee for our area – Larry Berry. It was a cordial meeting. 



Dear Superintendent Coombs

To be clear, our concern regarding the Youthline material is that it promotes high risk sexual behaviour that can lead to injury and serious health problems. Public Health Ontario's, Provincial Infectious Diseases Advisory Committee on Communicable Diseases, 2014 categorizes "Higher Risk Sexual Behaviour" as "Sexual practices that may cause bleeding or abrasions, resulting in blood-to-blood contact between participants. Examples may include unprotected anal intercourse, fisting, the use of sex toys, rough sex, . . . " We feel that because this kind of high risk behaviour is promoted on Youthline, this site is not safe for any child or young person and so should not be accessible through the UCDSB website. By any reasonable standard, a web site that promotes high risk behaviour is inappropriate. We see no room for debate when it comes to the safety and well-being of our children.

Many Parents don't know what's happening in the schools!



What does this mean for parents and their children. It means that your child will be exposed to Gender Ideology by the school board and your child may be encouraged to attend Pride events whether you like it or not.



It means that your children and teens will be <u>provided access by the school board</u> to a <u>website</u> that features '<u>soft porn</u>' and that website's assurance that no one will be the wiser; "All our services are confidential and anonymous – we only know what you share with us. Our number will not show up on your phone bill. To learn more about our procedures and how to prevent our site from showing up in your computer's history, click <u>here</u>."

As of Oct 9, 2019 The Director decided to remove the hyper link to LGBT Youthline but still provide the phone numbers and a short description regarding the site. He explained that he would provide the contact (the phone numbers) but not the content (the direct link to the website). By October 9, 2019 I noticed that the changes had been made on Upper Canada's website

As of this month the school board's website presents the Youthline contact numbers only with a short description of the site – the inactive URL (web address) is removed. Clearly, the Mr. Sliwa, the <u>Director of Education</u> saw the merit in our argument regarding the <u>inappropriateness</u> of much of Youthine's material. Although he didn't state his agreement explicitly, his actions on the matter speak louder than words.

However the Youthliine connection as we will see is not gone but more insidious.

Category (Schools & Students) Effective Date: September 29, 2008. Last Revision Date: (25-Feb-19) Page 6 of 10

- c) Situations where the Principal shall NOT notify a Parent:
 - i) Pursuant to subsection 300.3 (3) of the Education Act, a principal shall NOT notify a parent of a student if, in the opinion of the principal, doing so would put the student at risk of harm from a parent of the student, such that notification is not in the student's best interest.
 - ii) Under subsection 301 (5.5) of the Education Act, when principals have decided not to notify the parents that their child was involved in a serious student incident, as described above, they must, in accordance with Ontario Regulation 472/07, document the rationale for this decision and notify both the teacher who reported the incident and the appropriate supervisory officer of this decision.
 - Principals shall also, if they determine it is appropriate to do so, inform other Board employees of this decision.
 - iv) In addition, principals should refer students to board resources or to a community-based service provider that can provide the appropriate type of confidential support when his or her parents are not called (e.g., counselling; a sexual assault centre; Kids Help Phone; Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgendered Youth Line18).

Bullying/Harassment Prevention and Intervention

A principal shall not notify a parent of a student if, in the opinion of the principal, doing so would put the student at risk of harm from a parent of the student, such that notification is not in the student's best interest. When principals decide not to notify the parents that their child was involved in a serious student incident, they must document the rationale for this decision and notify both the person who reported the incident and the appropriate supervisory officer of this decision. Principals shall also, if they determine it is appropriate to do so, inform other board employees of this decision. In

addition, principals should refer students to board resources or to a community-based service provider that can provide the appropriate type of confidential support when his or her parents are not called (eg. counselling; a sexual assault centre; Kids Help Phone; LGBT Youth Line).

Student Discipline: Procedure 126:1

Not Notifying a Parent/Guardian

Where, in the opinion of principal/vice-principal/teacher-in-charge/principal designate, providing information to the victim's parent/guardian would put the victim at risk of harm, such that notification would not be in the victim's best interests, or where the victim is an adult pupil and does NOT consent to his/her parent/guardian being informed, the principal/vice-principal/teacher-in-charge/principal designate shall not inform the victim's parent/guardian. A teacher-in-charge/principal designate shall report to the Administration at the earliest opportunity the reason(s) why notification was not provided to the parent/guardian. The principal or vice-principal shall:

The principal or vice-principal shall inform the victim of the steps being taken by the school to protect the victim's safety. These measures might include a Safety Plan and the implementation of prevention strategies identified in this procedure. Where the victim has been harassed, bullied or suffered violence as a result of one or more immutable characteristics, including any grounds protected by the Human Rights Code, or has been sexually assaulted, the principal or vice-principal shall provide the victim with contact information about professional supports, such as community agencies, public health facilities and telecommunications forums, such as a help-phone-line or website, that the victim may access for information, assistance and support. Supports might include Kids Help Phone and the Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual and Transgendered Youth Line. A written list of community contacts shall be provided to the victim and the victim shall be informed that the list is available on the Board's website.

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE

B2:16 School Operations – Code of Conduct Informing Parents/Guardians Page 1 of 2

2.2 Under Section 300.3(3) of the Education Act, the principal <u>is not</u> permitted to inform the parents of a victim when, in the principal's opinion, doing so would put the victim at risk of harm from the parent. For example: *During an investigation of an incident of homophobic bullying, a student discloses to the principal that he is gay, and that he has not shared/is not ready to share this information about his sexual orientation with his parents. He says that if his parents are told, they will force him to leave home. He says he would rather commit suicide than face his parents on this issue.* Principals should refer students to board resources or to a community-based service provider that can provide the appropriate type of confidential support when the student's parents are not called.

Under subsection 301(5.5) of the Education Act, when principals have decided not to notify the parents that their child was involved in a serious student incident, as described above, they must, in accordance with Ontario Regulation 472/07, document the rationale for this decision and notify both the teacher who reported the incident and the appropriate supervisory officer of this decision. Principals shall also, if they determine it is appropriate to do so, inform other board employees of this decision. In addition, principals should refer the student to board resources or to a community-based service provider that can provide the appropriate type of confidential support when the student's parents are not called (e.g., counselling; a sexual assault centre; Kids Help Phone; Lesbian, Gay, Bi, Trans (LGBT) Youth Line¹⁷).





September 17, 2019, Likely emboldened by Ford's sexed flip flop, the Ontario Human Rights Commission sent the Toronto Catholic board a letter admonishing it to add "gender identity" and "gender expression" to its Code of Conduct.

October 31, 2019 – Minister of Education, Stephen Lecce, declared: "My message to the board is quite clear. My expectation is that every child irrespective of their differences can see themselves reflected in schools and more importantly that they will adhere to the Ontario Human Rights Code." (Click here to read the article.) Lecce could have stayed above the fray and recognized the Catholic boards' denominational rights, but instead, he chose to use his bully pulpit to pressure the board to include the terms.

November 7, 2019 – Trustees voted 8 to 4 to add gender ideology to the board's Code of Conduct, citing the directive from the Ministry of Education to comply.


But we must speak in His love and with His love . . .
